I pledge never to intentionally bring harm, or let others bring harm, to the cat(s) and that, should a situation arise in which I am unable or unwilling to keep the cat(s), *Second Chances* will be immediately notified and given the opportunity to properly trap and relocate the animals.

I understand that it is important to confine my barn cat(s) in their new surroundings for *at least the first 2 weeks* and that at this time, litter will be provided by *Second Chances* but it is my responsibility to manage it. **If this important step is missed, most cats will take off, never to be seen again.**

I agree to provide cat food and fresh water daily.

I agree that I **may not** have rodent poison of any kind on the premises. Additionally, antifreeze must be kept tightly sealed and in a location that is not accessible to the cats. I understand these poisons are appealing to animals and will result in fatalities.

I agree to provide 24/7 access to warm, adequate shelter.

In the event of illness or injury to the animal, I promise to immediately notify *Second Chances* and will cooperate with them to see that the animal receives necessary care.

I certify that the information I have given is true and I understand that false information may result in the nullification of this agreement. In the event *Second Chances* should feel there is a cause for concern, representatives from their organization may choose to revoke my permission to serve as a host for their program and **have permission to retrieve the animals from my property.**
